APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Vladimir PRUSA (Czechoslovakia)

- 1. At its 1113th meeting, on 17 December 1965, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretariat (A/C.5/1052) announcing the resignation, with effect from 6 December 1965, of Mr. B.N. Chakravarty as a member of the Committee on Contributions.
- 2. The members of the Fifth Committee had previously been invited to suggest the name of a person who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to the Committee on Contributions in accordance with the provisions of rules 156 and 157 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly. At the time the matter was considered by the Fifth Committee one name had been put forward in respect of the above-mentioned vacancy.
- 3. To decide who should be recommended for appointment, the Committee voted by secret ballot. The result of the ballot was as follows:

4. Mr. Parthasarathi (India), having received the required majority, was declared recommended for appointment as a member of the Committee on Contributions for the unexpired portion of Mr. Chakravarty's term of office, namely, for the period ending on 31 December 1966.
