Report of the Second Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. A. RAMAHOLIMIHASO (Madagascar)

1. At its 1336th plenary meeting, on 24 September 1965, the General Assembly allocated to the Second Committee agenda item 43 entitled "Decentralization of the economic and social activities of the United Nations: (a) report of the Secretary-General; (b) report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions".

2. The Committee considered this item at its 1019th meeting, on 16 December 1965. 3. In considering the item, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/5998); a report by the Secretary-General (E/4075 and Corr.1 (English only)); a report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/6114) and the relevant part of the report of the Economic and Social Council to the General Assembly at its twentieth session¹.

4. The representative of Ghana proposed that consideration of this item should be postponed until the twenty-first session of the General Assembly.
5. The Committee approved by acclamation the procedural proposal by the

representative of Ghana mentioned in the preceding paragraph.
