IMPLEMENTATION OF THE DECLARATION ON THE GRANTING OF INDEPENDENCE TO COLONIAL COUNTRIES AND PEOPLES

Note verbale dated 17 November 1965 from the Permanent Representative of Czechoslovakia to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Representative of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to acknowledge the receipt of the Secretary-General's note No. TR 300 SORH of 12 November 1965 transmitting a copy of resolution 2022 (XX) adopted by the General Assembly on 5 November 1965.

In response to this letter and in full conformity and agreement with Security Council resolution 216 (1965) of 12 November 1965, the Permanent Representative of the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic wishes to declare that the Czechoslovak Socialist Republic associates itself with those countries which refuse to recognize an arbitrarily declared racist régime in Southern Rhodesia and will support all measures taken by the United Nations against this racist régime to bring it to an end.

It is requested that this letter be circulated to the Member States as an official document of the General Assembly.
