ADDENDUM

Note by the Secretary-General: In addition to the
communications reproduced in documents A/3302 and Add.1-17,
the following communication from the Permanent Representative
of Ecuador to the United Nations has been received by the
Secretary-General.

New York, 13 November 1956

I have the honour, on the instructions of my Government, to place at your disposal an Ecuadorian military contingent of up to five hundred men, depending on the conditions, of which you are requested to inform me.

I request you to take into account this offer by the Government of Ecuador and to communicate to me as soon as possible all the details I must transmit to my Government to enable it to implement this military contribution.
