ADDENDUM

Note by the Secretary-General: In addition to the communications reproduced in document A/3302 and Add.1-24, the following communication from the Permanent Representative of Norway to the United Nations has been received by the Secretary-General.

New York, 19 November 1956

Referring to my letter of 5 November 1956,<sup>1/</sup> I hereby have the honour to inform you about the following unanimous decision adopted by the Norwegian Parliament on 16 November 1956, concerning additional Norwegian forces to the United Nations Emergency Force.

(1) The original Norwegian force contribution will be increased in order to make possible the setting up of a joint Danish-Norwegian battalion.

(2) One field ambulance/medical unit totalling 230 men will be ready for transfer as from 17 November. The unit is fully equipped except for vehicles.
