The Permanent Mission of India to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to acknowledge his letter No. TR 300 PORTE of 7 February 1966, transmitting a copy of resolution 2107 (XX) concerning the question of Territories under Portuguese administration adopted by the General Assembly at its 1407th plenary meeting on 21 December 1965.

India co-sponsored this resolution. Long before the adoption of this resolution the Government of India had taken the measures outlined in the resolution which is aimed to speedily put an end to Portuguese colonialism.
