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EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Proceedings of the Third International Conference on the Peaceful Uses of Atomic Energy are published in a single multilingual edition of sixteen volumes.

The first fifteen volumes contain (a) the 739 papers actually presented at the Conference, each printed in the original language of submission and followed by an abstract in the other three languages of the Conference;* and (b) the records, in all four languages, of the discussions which took place at the various sessions making up the Conference Programme. Volume 1 contains also some other material, largely of a formal nature, which is published in the language of submission or oral delivery, followed in the case of French, Russian or Spanish originals by an English translation.

The present volume is intended to serve as a guide to the papers and discussions. It comprises the following indexes and lists:

Numerical index of papers;
Author index;
Index of speakers at discussions;
Subject index;
Index of papers by submitting country or organization;
Contents of the Proceedings.

Detailed explanations for each of the above are given below.

NUMERICAL INDEX OF PAPERS

This index lists the individual papers serially, omitting those which were withdrawn by Governments before the Conference, or never actually submitted for other reasons. The title of each paper is given in the language of publication, followed, where appropriate, by an English translation. The names of authors are also listed (both in Russian and transliterated into English according to United Nations rules in the case of papers published in Russian), as well as the volume of the Proceedings in which the paper is to be found, with the corresponding page number.

AUTHOR INDEX

This index lists, alphabetically, *all* authors of Conference papers, followed by the serial number of the corresponding papers and the volume to

which they were assigned. Names of the authors of papers published in Russian are given in their transliterated English form.

For papers with no personal author(s), the index gives the originating country and abbreviated corporate author, or in one case the abbreviation for a United Nations agency as shown below:

INDEX OF SPEAKERS AT DISCUSSIONS

This index lists all participants who are on record as having taken part in the discussion of papers at the various sessions, the names being transliterated into English where appropriate, and followed by the name of the country of the speaker or that of the organization which he represented, the symbol of the session at which he spoke and the volume in which the record of that session appears.

SUBJECT INDEX

This keyword index has been prepared by a mechanized method currently used for indexing scientific documents, abstracts, etc. Keywords are taken *only from the titles* of papers. Each significant word in a title is used as a keyword and has its appropriate entry in the index. Each title is listed once for each keyword, and therefore appears as many times as the number of keywords it contains. To the right of each entry is the serial number of the paper. This directs the user to the numerical index, where he will find more complete information about the paper.

Owing to the methods used for its compilation, it has been possible to produce this index *only in English*.

INDEX OF PAPERS BY SUBMITTING COUNTRY OR ORGANIZATION

In this index all papers are grouped by originating country or by specialized or related United Nations agency; within each group, they are listed in numerical order.

CONTENTS OF THE PROCEEDINGS

This section lists, *in English only* and in some detail, the material included in the sixteen volumes of the Proceedings. The serial numbers of all published papers are again given, under headings and sub-headings which are essentially those of the Conference Programme.

NOTE EXPLICATIVE

Les Actes de la troisième Conférence internationale sur l'utilisation de l'énergie atomique à des fins pacifiques sont publiés sous la forme d'une édition unique, multilingue, de seize volumes.

Les quinze premiers volumes contiennent: *a* les 739 mémoires effectivement présentés à la Conférence, chacun d'eux étant reproduit dans la langue originale dans laquelle il a été soumis, et suivi d'un résumé dans les trois autres langues de la Conférence *; et *b* les comptes rendus, dans les quatre langues, des discussions qui ont eu lieu lors des diverses séances composant le programme de la Conférence. Le volume 1 contient aussi certains autres textes, pour la plupart de caractère non technique, qui sont publiés dans la langue dans laquelle ils ont été présentés par écrit ou oralement, et sont suivis, lorsque cette langue est l'espagnol, le français ou le russe, d'une traduction en anglais.

Le présent volume est destiné à faciliter la lecture des mémoires et discussions. Il comprend les index et listes ci-après:

INDEX NUMÉRIQUE DES MÉMOIRES

Cet index donne les mémoires par ordre numérique, à l'exclusion de ceux qui ont été retirés par les gouvernements avant la Conférence ou n'ont jamais été effectivement présentés pour d'autres raisons. Le titre de chaque mémoire est donné dans la langue de publication; il est suivi, le cas échéant, d'une traduction en anglais. L'index donne aussi les noms des auteurs (à la fois en russe et translittérés en anglais selon les règles de l'ONU dans le cas des mémoires publiés en russe), ainsi que le volume des Actes dans lequel figure chaque mémoire avec l'indication de la page correspondante.

Труды третьей Международной конференции по использованию атомной энергии в мирных целях опубликованы единым многоязычным изданием из 16 томов.

Первые пятнадцать томов состоят из: а) 739 докладов, фактически представленных на Конференции; каждый из них отпечатан на языке оригинала и сопровождается аннотацией на трех других языках Конференции *; б) протоколов дискуссий на всех четырех языках, которые имели место на различных заседаниях, входивших в программу Конференции. В томе 1 содержится также некоторый другой материал, преимущественно не-технического характера, который публикуется на языке оригинала или устного выступления, причем оригиналы на французском, русском и испанском языках сопровождаются английским переводом.

Настоящий том должен служить справочником по докладам и дискуссиям. В него входят следующие указатели и перечни:

В этом указателе перечислены отдельные доклады посерийно, за исключением тех, которые были взяты правительствами обратно до начала Конференции или фактически никогда не были представлены по другим причинам. Название каждого доклада дается на языке публикаций, в сопровождении, там, где это необходимо, английского перевода. Приводятся также фамилии авторов (на русском языке и в транслитерации на английский язык в соответствии с правилами Организации Объединенных Наций — в отношении докладов, изданных на русском языке) и том

трудов Конференции, в котором следует искать данный доклад, с соответствующим указанием страницы.

АВТОРСКИЙ УКАЗАТЕЛЬ

ТЕМАТИЧЕСКИЙ УКАЗАТЕЛЬ

Этот указатель слов-ключей подготовлен с помощью механизированного метода, обычно применяемого для индексации научных документов, аннотаций и т. д. Слова-ключи берутся **лишь из заглавий докладов**. Каждое значимое слово в заглавии используется в

качестве слова-ключа и имеет свое соответствующее место в указателе. Каждое заглавие упоминается один раз для каждого слова-ключа и поэтому появляется столько раз, сколько в нем содержится слов-ключей. Вправо от каждой записи в указателе приводится серийный номер доклада. Это отсылает читателя к цифровому указателю, где он найдет более полную информацию об этом докладе.

Методы, которые были использованы для составления указателя, обусловили тот факт, что этот указатель мог быть издан **только на английском языке**.

NOTA EXPLICATIVA

Las Actas de la tercera Conferencia Internacional sobre la Utilización de la Energía Atómica con Fines Pacíficos se publican en una sola edición plurilingüe que consta de dieciséis volúmenes.

Los quince primeros volúmenes contienen: *a)* las 739 memorias presentadas realmente a la Conferencia, cada una de las cuales figura en el idioma original y va seguida de un resumen en los otros tres idiomas de la Conferencia *; y *b)* las actas, en los cuatro idiomas, de las discusiones celebradas en las distintas sesiones integrantes del programa de la Conferencia.
