In a letter dated 15 December 1967 addressed to the Secretary-General, the Permanent Representative of Libya to the United Nations stated:

"The International Day was widely observed throughout the country. The Secretary-General's message was published in Libyan newspapers. Libyan broadcasting stations and newspapers denounced the policies of racial discrimination and apartheid. In addition, the Ministry of Education was instructed to develop a curriculum which would reflect the various resolutions adopted by the United Nations on apartheid and racial discrimination."
