QUESTION OF THE CONTINUATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES*

Note by the Secretary-General

- 1. The General Assembly, by resolution 1783 (XVII) of 7 December 1962, decided to review, not later than at its twenty-second session, the arrangements for the Office of the High Commissioner for Refugees, with a view to determining whether the Office should be further continued beyond 31 December 1968. By the same resolution the Assembly decided to continue the Office of the High Commissioner for a period of five years from 1 January 1964 on the basis of the Statute of the Office.
- 2. The Statute of the Oficce of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees is contained in the annex to General Assembly resolution 428 (V) of 14 December 1950.
