QUESTION OF THE CONTINUATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE
UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES*

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The General Assembly, by resolution 1783 (XVII) of 7 December 1962, decided to review, not later than at its twenty-second session, the arrangements for the Office of the High Commissioner for Refugees, with a view to determining whether the Office should be further continued beyond 31 December 1968. By the same resolution the Assembly decided to continue the Office of the High Commissioner for a period of five years from 1 January 1964 on the basis of the Statute of the Office.
2. The Statute of the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees is contained in the annex to General Assembly resolution 428 (V) of 14 December 1950.
