秘书长的说明

增 编

1. 根据经济及社会理事会有关决议,特别是1986年5月23日第1986/35号决议,人权委员会第四十六届会议需要按下列方式选举两年后任期届满的半数小组委员会委员及相应的候补委员:三名来自非洲国家的委员;三名来自亚洲国家的委员;一名来自东欧国家的委员;三名来自拉丁美洲国家的委员和三名来自西欧和其它国家的委员。

2. 秘书长在E/CN.4/1990/48号和Add.1-3号文件中向委员会通知了截至1990年1月25日收到的小组委员会委员和候补委员候选人提名。该文件还载有已收到的有关委员和候补委员候选人的履历材料。

3. 1990年1月8日,印度政府通知秘书长,它决定撤销穆利达尔·班达雷的候选人资格,提名拉金达·萨查尔先生参加小组委员会的选举。1990年2月7日,巴拿马政府通知秘书长,它决定撤销其对小组委员会选举的提名。

4. 本文件载有截至1990年2月8日的小组委员会委员提名的增订名单。本文件还载有1990年1月25日以后收到的履历材料(见附件)。

5. 新的来文和提名将转载于增编。

Professional background

- 1952 Started legal practice in Punjab High Court
- 1954 Elected General-Secretary of the Punjab High Court Bar Association
- 1967-68 Unanimously elected President of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association
- 1970 Appointed Judge of the High Court of Delhi
- 1975 Appointed First Chief Justice of the Sikkim High Court. Set up the High Court of Sikkim
- 1977 Appointed Chairman of the high-powered expert committee (commonly known as Sachar Committee) set up by the Government of India to review the Companies Act and Monopolies and Restrictive Trade Practices Act. The Committee's recommendations have been accepted and incorporated into the 1984 Amendment Act.
- Appointed Chief Justice of Delhi High Court and retired from this position on 22 December 1985.

Present position

Senior advocate, Supreme Court of India.

Patron of the Indian Council of Legal Aid and Advice Society.

Honorary Vice-President of the Indian Society of International Law.

President of the People's Union for Civil Liberties, a non-governmental organization active in the sphere of human rights.
