PROPOSED BY THAILAND

REQUEST OF THAILAND FOR OBSERVATION UNDER THE PEACE  
OBSERVATION COMMISSION

Note by the Secretary-General: The Secretary-General has the honour to circulate herewith to the Members of the General Assembly the text of a letter dated 20 August 1954 which he has received from the Minister for Foreign Affairs of Thailand.

New York, 20 August 1954

With reference to my letter No. 259/2497, dated 7 July B.E. 2497 (1954), <sup>1/</sup> concerning a proposed additional item for inclusion in the agenda of the eighth session of the General Assembly, I have the honour to inform you that I have been instructed by my Government not to press for a resumed session of the Eighth Assembly.

I am, however, to reserve the right of my Government to raise the question, if need be, during the forthcoming session of the General Assembly.
