ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE TWENTY-THIRD REGULAR SESSION AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

Second report of the General Committee

- 1. At its 175th meeting, on 17 October 1968, the General Committee considered the request submitted by the Secretary-General (A/7224) for the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-third session of an additional item entitled "Conference of Non-Nuclear-Weapon States: Final Document of the Conference". The Committee decided to recommend that the item should be included in the agenda and allocated to the First Committee on the understanding that during the discussion of the item the Chairman of the First Committee would consult that Committee on the advisability of referring to the Second Committee those portions of the report of the Conference which might be of interest to the Second Committee.
- 2. At the same meeting, the General Committee considered a request by Italy (A/7221) for the inclusion in the agenda of an additional item entitled "Necessity of amending article IV of the Treaty on Principles Governing the Activities of States in the Exploration and Use of Outer Space, including the Moon and Other Celestial Bodies". Following statements by the representatives of the United States of America, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, the United Kingdom and India, the representative of Italy announced that his delegation had decided to withdraw its request for the inclusion of the item in the agenda.
- 3. The General Committee also considered the question of the allocation of the item entitled "One day of war for peace", which the General Assembly had already included in its agenda as item 92. The Committee decided to recommend to the Assembly that that item should be referred to the Second Committee.
