ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE TWENTY-THIRD REGULAR SESSION
AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS

Third report of the General Committee

1. At its 176th meeting, on 1 November 1968, the General Committee considered the request submitted by Austria, Bulgaria, the Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Canada, Ghana, Guatemala, Guinea, Guyana, India, Iran, Italy, Lebanon, Peru, the Philippines, Somalia, Sweden, Togo, and Trinidad and Tobago (A/7225 and Add.1) for the inclusion in the agenda of the twenty-third session of an additional item entitled "Celebration of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the United Nations". The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item should be included in the agenda and considered directly in plenary meeting.
2. At the same meeting, following a statement by the Secretary-General regarding the health of the President of the General Assembly, the General Committee, at the suggestion of the representative of Sweden, decided to recommend that the Assembly should convey to the President its best wishes for a speedy recovery.
