ELECTION OF THE UNITED NATIONS HIGH COMMISSIONER FOR REFUGEES

Note by the Secretary-General

1. At its 1720th plenary meeting, on 15 November 1968, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the Secretary-General, re-elected Prince Sadruddin Aga Khan as United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees for a five-year term from 1 January 1969 to 31 December 1973.

2. By its resolution 2957 (XXVII) of 12 December 1972, the General Assembly decided to continue the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees for a further period of five years from 1 January 1974.

3. The Secretary-General now has the honour to propose that the term of office of Prince Sadruddin Aga Khan as United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees be extended for a further period of five years from 1 January 1974 to 31 December 1978.
