Financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Second Committee (A/6508, para. 12)

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. In accordance with rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, the Fifth Committee considered at its ll41st meeting, on 7 November 1966, the financial implications of the draft resolution recommended by the Second Committee (A/6508, para. 12). The Committee had before it reports of the Secretary-General (A/6481) and the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions (A/6493).
- 2. The committee decided without objection to inform the General Assembly that the adoption of the draft resolution submitted by the Second Committee in its report concerning the establishment of a United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) (A/6508, para. 12) would have the following effects upon the budget estimates for 1967:
- (a) A new budget section (21), specifically for UNIDO, would be provided in the 1967 budget;
- (b) Credits in sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 10 and 11 of the 1967 budget estimates amounting in total to \$3,751,600 would be transferred to the new section;
- (c) Additional provision to an amount of \$1,448,400 would be required, thus providing a total of \$5 million in the new section 21, for the purposes of UNIDO.
