CREDENTIALS OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE SEVENTH SESSION
OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Second report of the Credentials Committee^{1/}

Chairman: Mr. Karim Azkoul (Lebanon)

1. The Credentials Committee met again at United Nations Headquarters on 19 December 1952. The Committee consists of the following Member States:
Belgium, Burma, Lebanon, New Zealand, Panama, Paraguay, Sweden,
Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United States of America
2. Mr. Karim Azkoul, representative of Lebanon, was unanimously elected Chairman of the Committee, and was also appointed Rapporteur, in the absence of Mr. Jamil Mikaoui.
3. The Committee examined the communications transmitted to the Secretary-General (A/CR/5) since its first meeting by the following Member States:
Argentina, Ecuador, Guatemala, Nicaragua, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia,
Syria, Turkey, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland
4. The Committee found that the governments of the Member States listed above had submitted credentials for their representatives completely satisfying the requirements of rule 27 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly.
5. All Member States, therefore, have furnished their representatives to the seventh session with credentials completely satisfying the requirements of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly.
6. The Credentials Committee recommends that the General Assembly should adopt the following resolutions:
