ORGANIZATION OF THE WORK OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

Report of the General Committee

1. The General Committee, at its 83rd and 84th meetings held on 15 and 18 December 1952, considered the organization of the work of the General Assembly. At its 84th meeting, it decided to make the following recommendations to the General Assembly:

(1) That meetings of the seventh regular session of the General Assembly should be suspended not later than 23 December 1952, to be resumed on 24 February 1953 or at an earlier date on the call of the President;

(2) That item 16 (b) - Reports of the United Nations Agent General for Korean Reconstruction, and item 70 - Complaint of non-compliance of States still detaining members of the Greek armed forces with the provisions of resolution 382 A (V), adopted by the General Assembly on 1 December 1950, recommending "the repatriation of all those among them who express the wish to be repatriated", should be reallocated to the First Committee.

2. The General Committee further decided at its 84th meeting to recommend to the General Assembly the adoption of the following resolution:

The General Assembly

Decides

1. To include in the provisional agenda of the eighth regular session an item entitled "Question of a change in the opening date of regular sessions of the General Assembly";

2. To instruct the Secretary-General to prepare a report, for circulation to Members, not later than five weeks before the opening of the eighth regular session, on the practical consequences of a change in the opening date of regular sessions from the third Tuesday in September to another date earlier or later in the year.
