## NOTE BY THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

- 1. At the 78th plenary meeting of its forty-fourth session, on 8 December 1989, the General Assembly adopted resolution 44/51 entitled, "Protection and security of small States". 1/
- 2. In paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 of the resolution, the General Assembly:
  - "4. <u>Urges</u> the Secretary-General to pay special attention to monitoring the security situation of small States and to consider making use of the provisions of Article 99 of the Charter;
  - "5. <u>Invites</u> the Secretary-General to explore ways and means, within the United Nations and in accordance with the Charter, of preserving the security of small States;
  - "6. Requests the Secretary-General to hold consultations with the members of the Security Council and interested Governments and to submit a report to it at its forty-sixth session on the implementation of the present resolution."
