Report of the Fifth Committee

Reporteur: Mr. H.M. ANSON (Pakistan)

1. The Fifth Committee, at its 378th meeting held on 24 September 1953, considered the financial report and accounts of the United Nations for the year ended 31 December 1952 and the report of the Board of Auditors^{1/} together with the relevant comments of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions as included in paragraphs 241 to 251 of its first report to the eighth session of the General Assembly.^{2/}
2. The Fifth Committee agreed with a proposal made by the Chairman that consideration of the issues raised by the Advisory Committee in paragraphs 242 to 247 of its report relative to the award of costs by the Administrative Tribunal should be deferred until a later and more appropriate date.
3. Subject to this understanding, and without further discussion, it was decided, by 47 votes to none, with 5 abstentions, to recommend to the General Assembly the adoption of the following resolution:
