Administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions A and C recommended by the Special Political Committee (A/9872, para. 15)

Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 1672nd meeting, on 25 November 1974, the Fifth Committee, in accordance with rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statements of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/1629 and 1609) concerning the administrative and financial implications of draft resolutions A and C recommended by the Special Political Committee (A/9872, para. 15).

2. In his statement, the Secretary-General indicated that, should the General Assembly approve the draft resolutions recommended by the Special Political Committee, additional appropriations of \$76,800 and \$8,400, respectively, would be required under section 20 of the programme budget for the biennium 1974-1975. With respect to the latter item, the Secretary-General had indicated that a total appropriation of \$16,800 would be required but that an amount of \$8,400 was included in the performance report for the biennium 1974-1975.

3. In an oral statement to the Fifth Committee, the Chairman of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions indicated that the Advisory Committee agreed with the cost estimates submitted by the Secretary-General. A/9881 English Page 2

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

4. The Fifth Committee decided, without objection, to inform the General Assembly that:

(a) Should draft resolution A contained in the report of the Special Political Committee (A/9872) be adopted, an additional appropriation of \$76,800 would be required under section 20 of the programme budget for the biennium 1974-1975;

(b) Should draft resolution C contained in the report of the Special Political Committee (A/9872) be adopted, an additional appropriation of \$8,400 would be required under section 20 of the programme budget for the biennium 1974-1975.
