ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 21 June 1974 from the President of the Security Council
to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the General Assembly resolution 352 (1974) below on the admission of Grenada to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 1778th meeting, on 21 June 1974:

"The Security Council,

"Having considered the application of Grenada for admission to membership in the United Nations, 1/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that Grenada be admitted to membership in the United Nations."

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim records of the 1777th and 1778th meetings of the Security Council, at which the application of Grenada was discussed.
