REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

Letter dated 24 March 1975 from the Permanent Representative of Bulgaria to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Mission of the People's Republic of Bulgaria to the United Nations was surprised to note that the provisional list of representatives to the first session of the Commission on Transnational Corporations shows as the representative of the Federal Republic of Germany Prof. Eberhard Günther, President of the Federal Office for the Supervision of Cartels and Trusts in the Federal Republic of Germany, an office as the seat of which West Berlin is being misused.

This nomination stands in contradiction to the Quadripartite Agreement of 3 September 1971 on Berlin (West) and runs counter to the basic aims of this important international agreement which is to contribute to the lessening of international tensions and to the establishment of good-neighbourly relations and co-operation.

For this reason the Permanent Mission of the People's Republic of Bulgaria to the United Nations considers as unacceptable Prof. Günther's nomination to the Commission on Transnational Corporations.

I would be grateful to you for having this letter circulated as an official document of the General Assembly under item 12 of the preliminary list of items to be included in the provisional agenda of the thirtieth session.
