REDUCTION OF THE INCREASING GAP BETWEEN THE DEVELOPED COUNTRIES  
AND THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

Report of the Second Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Luis LASCARRO (Colombia)

1. The General Assembly, at its 2237th meeting, on 21 September 1974, allocated to the Second Committee agenda item 47, entitled "Reduction of the increasing gap between the developed countries and the developing countries".
2. The Second Committee considered this item in the context of the general debate at its 1587th to 1598th and 1600th to 1601st meetings, between 23 September and 8 October 1974. The Committee resumed its consideration of the item at its 1645th meeting, on 5 December 1974. An account of the discussion of the Committee is contained in the relevant summary records (A/C.2/SR.1587-1598, 1600, 1601 and 1645).
3. At its 1645th meeting, on 5 December, the Committee adopted without a vote, a draft resolution submitted by the Chairman (A/C.2/L.1396) (see para. 4 below).

RECOMMENDATION OF THE SECOND COMMITTEE

4. The Second Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft resolution:

REDUCTION OF THE INCREASING GAP BETWEEN THE DEVELOPED COUNTRIES  
AND THE DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

The General Assembly,

Having considered the item on the reduction of the increasing gap between developed and developing countries,

Decides that the subject-matter of this item be fully taken into account by the General Assembly at its special session devoted to development and international economic co-operation to be held in 1975.
