## Letter dated 11 June 1985 from the Permanent Representative of Afghanistan to the United Nations addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that the Chargé d'affaires of the Pakistan Embassy at Kabul was summoned to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan at 10.00 a.m. on 11 June 1985 and the following was pointed out to him by the Director of the First Political Department:

"The militarist Government of Pakistan, in continuation of its baseless charges against the Government of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan, has once again claimed that Afghan aircraft have allegedly violated the airspace of Chitral and Quetta on 3 and 4 June 1985. It has also claimed that on the same dates the security posts located south-east of Arando and Shahin have come under fire which have caused no damages.

"The Government of the Democratic Republic of Afghanistan, after thoroughly investigating the case, considers these allegations of the militarist Government of Pakistan as void of truth and categorically rejects them. It is pointed out that the Pakistani authorities should put an immediate end to such accusations which have no result, but increase tension in the frontier areas."

I have further the honour to request that this letter be circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under items 72, 73, 132, 133 and 138 of the preliminary list, and of the Security Council.
