ADVISORY COMMETTEE ON ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY QUESTIONS

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. H.M. AHSON (Pakistan)

- 1. At its 392nd meeting held on 19 October 1955, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/2417) concerning the vacancies which will occur in the membership of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions at the expiration of the term of office of three of its members on 31 December 1953.
- 2. The Chairwan had previously invited members of the Fifth Committee to suggest names of parsons who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to membership of the Advisory Committee in accordance with the provisions of rules 154 and 155 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly. At the time when the matter was considered by the Fifth Committee, five candidates had been proposed.
- 3. For the purpose of deciding who should be recommended for appointment, the Committee proceeded to a vote by secret ballot in accordance with the rules of procedure of the General Assembly relating to elections. The result of the ballot was as follows:
