As indicated in its report of 17 November on Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories (A/2556, paragraph 45), the Fourth Committee had decided to keep open this item and postponed further debate. At its 395th meeting, following statements by the representatives of India and the United Kingdom, the Committee concluded its discussion of this item.

ELECTION OF TWO MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE ON
INFORMATION FROM NON-SELF-GOVERNING TERRITORIES

The General Assembly, by resolution 646 (VII) adopted on 10 December 1952, instructed the Fourth Committee, acting on behalf of the General Assembly, to fill such vacancies as might occur among the non-Administering Members of the Committee on Information from Non-Self-Governing Territories. Consequently, at its 395th meeting, the Fourth Committee elected Burma and Guatemala in place of Cuba and Pakistan.
