1. At its 1270th meeting, on 29 November 1968, the Fifth Committee considered the statement of the Secretary-General (A/C.5/L.1194), submitted in accordance with rule 154 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, on the administrative and financial implications of draft resolution I recommended by the Special Political Committee in its report (A/7348) for approval by the General Assembly and dealing with the activities and requirements in 1969 of the Special Committee on the Policies of Apartheid of the Government of the Republic of South Africa.
2. The recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions on this matter appear in document A/7355.
3. The Fifth Committee decided, by 75 votes to 1, with 3 abstentions, to accept the recommendations of the Advisory Committee and to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt the draft resolution, an additional appropriation of \$80,000 would be requested for 1969 as follows:
