Note by the Secretary-General

1. Under General Assembly resolution 2152 (XXI) of 17 November 1966, the Industrial Development Board of the United Nations Industrial Development Organization is "to report annually to the General Assembly through the Economic and Social Council". The Council "may transmit to the Organization and to the General Assembly such comments on the report as it may deem appropriate".
2. The report of the Industrial Development Board on the work of its second session^{1/} was before the Economic and Social Council at its forty-fifth session. The Council, in resolution 1349 (XLV) of 31 July 1968 took note of the Board's report and transmitted it to the General Assembly at its twenty-third session. An account of the discussion at the forty-fifth session appears in chapter IX of the annual report of the Council to the General Assembly.^{2/}
