"In accordance with the instructions of my Government I have the honour to place on record, in connection with the signature and subsequent ratification of the Treaty concerning the Accession of the Kingdom of Spain to the European Communities and the application of Community regulations to the territory of Gibraltar, in the terms agreed in the Act concerning the conditions of accession, that this accession does not involve any alteration in the position of the Kingdom of Spain concerning Gibraltar and does not affect the bilateral negotiating process established in conformity with the terms of the joint communiqué agreed with Your Excellency in Brussels on 27 November 1984.

I have the honour to propose that this note and Your Excellency's reply shall be regarded as placing on record the positions of both Governments."

I have the honour to confirm to Your Excellency that the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, in connection with the signature and subsequent ratification of the Treaty concerning the Accession of the Kingdom of Spain to the European Communities and the application of Community regulations to the territory of Gibraltar, in the terms agreed in the Act concerning the conditions of accession, places on record that accession by the Kingdom of Spain does not involve any alteration in the position of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland concerning Gibraltar and does not affect the bilateral negotiating process established in conformity with the terms of the joint communiqué agreed with Your Excellency in Brussels on 27 November 1984.
