AS RESULT WIDESPREAD ABSTENTIONS IN ELECTIONS 23 DECEMBER 1956 FRENCH GOVERNMENT
LAUNCHING FURIOUS ASSAULT ON PEOPLE ESPECIALLY IN SANAGA MARITIME REGION STOP
ENTIRE KAMERUN INVADED SOLDIERS FROM FRENCH COLONIES STOP COUNTLESS DEAD AND LARGESCALE DAILY ARRESTS STOP URGENTLY REQUEST INTERNATIONAL ASSISTANCE AND STEPS TO ALLOW

HAVE HONOUR REGRET INFORM YOU SITUATION IN KAMERUN ALARMING STOP AFTER TERRITORIAL ELECTIONS 23 DECEMBER 1956 GOVERNMENT SAVAGELY UNDERTOOK TERRIBLE WAR SANAGA MARITIME REGION STOP MILITARY FORCES FROM FRENCH COLONIES INVADED ALL KAMERUN STOP NUMEROUS ARRESTS OCCURRING DAILY IN ALL REGIONS STOP URGE SPEEDY DISPATCH INTERNATIONAL TROOPS TO PROTECT REMAINING INHABITANTS STOP ALSO REQUEST TAKE ACTION FOR ISSUE PASSPORTS TO PEOPLE'S REPRESENTATIVES STOP GRATEFUL YOUR ACTION - UPC BRANCHES YAOUNDE

WE PROTEST AGAINST BRITISH FRENCH AUTHORITIES REFUSAL ISSUE PASSPORTS KAMERUN REPRESENTATIVES TO DEFEND PROGRAMME FOR IMMEDIATE UNIFICATION AND INDEPENDENCE OF KAMERUN TO BE SUBMITTED UNATIONS ASSEMBLY STOP THIS ACTION DESIGNED COVER UP ODIOUS CRIME AGAINST INNOCENT KAMERUN PEOPLE WHO CLAIM RIGHT SELF-DETERMINATION STOP REQUEST UNATIONS ACTION TO ENABLE KAMERUN REPRESENTATIVES ATTEND PRESENT SESSION ASSEMBLY - FOSSO GENERAL SECRETARY UPC
