Our Organization wish could come to express all their national problem of the Cameroonians before the U.N.O. General Assembly.

According to the U.N.O. Charter and the Trusteeship Agreement, the majority of the Cameroons people attain to the term of the Trusteeship System: the Unification and Independence of Cameroons Trust Territory.

Therefore, as the British and French Governments always reject it, could you consider and call for representative of our Organization? This will be a final justice according to Article 76b of the United Nations Charter.
