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### Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [1718 \(2006\)](#)

#### Note verbale dated 6 March 2017 from the Permanent Mission of Ecuador to the United Nations addressed to the Chair of the Committee

The Permanent Mission of Ecuador to the United Nations presents its compliments to the Chair of the Security Council Committee established pursuant to resolution [1718 \(2006\)](#) and, in addition to the information provided in its note verbale dated 29 June 2012 ([S/AC.49/2012/6](#)), has the honour to report that the Government of the Republic of Ecuador, for the purposes of compliance with the provisions and prohibitions contained in resolutions [1718 \(2006\)](#), [1874 \(2009\)](#), [2087 \(2013\)](#), [2094 \(2013\)](#), [2270 \(2016\)](#) and [2321 \(2016\)](#), has made the content of those resolutions known to all relevant State institutions.

The Permanent Mission of Ecuador also reiterates that Ecuador does not transfer or provide weapons to the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, nor does it receive weapons from that country; that it does not transfer or trade materials or items prohibited by the above-mentioned resolutions from or with the Democratic People's Republic of Korea; that the development, production, possession, sale, import, transport, stockpiling and use of chemical, biological and nuclear weapons are prohibited by the Constitution of Ecuador and severely punished by Ecuadorean criminal law; that the Comprehensive Organic Criminal Code of Ecuador provides for compliance with Security Council sanctions, including account freezes, and the Financial Analysis Unit, the Office of the Attorney-General and the National Police of Ecuador accordingly have lists of entities, goods and individuals subject to the sanctions established by the above-mentioned Security Council resolutions.
