ORGANIZATION OF A UNITED NATIONS POSTAL ADMINISTRATION

Resolution adopted by the General Assembly at its
305th plenary meeting on 16 November 1950

(adopted on the report of the Fifth Committee (A/1507))

The General Assembly,

Referring to resolutions 232 (III) of 8 October 1948 and 342 (IV) of 20 October 1949, adopted at its third and fourth sessions respectively, and in particular to paragraphs 2 and 3 of resolution 342 (IV),

Having considered the report of the Secretary-General on the organization of a United Nations postal administration and the observations thereon submitted by the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions,

1. Takes note of the annexed draft agreement* between the United States of America and the United Nations for the establishment of a United Nations postal administration in conformity with the terms of the Headquarters Agreement;

2. Requests the Secretary-General to proceed with the conclusion of the aforesaid agreement and with the necessary arrangements for the establishment of a United Nations postal administration at the earliest possible date consistent with sound administrative arrangements;

3. Authorizes the Secretary-General to appoint a committee which shall be empowered to give final approval to designs for United Nations postage stamps;

4. Requests the Secretary-General to submit to the General Assembly, not later than the beginning of its seventh session, a comprehensive report on the establishment and operations of the United Nations postal administration.
