COMMUNICATION DATED 3 NOVEMBER 1950 FROM THE CHAIRMAN OF THE CHINESE DELEGATION ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

New York, 3 November 1950

I have received the following two telegraphic messages addressed by the Overseas Chinese in Bandoeng and Djakarta, Indonesia, to the President of the General Assembly and the Secretary-General of the United Nations.

1. The text of the message from various Chinese educational institutions in Bandoeng is as follows:

"WE APPEAL TO UNITED NATIONS TO DENOUNCE RUSSIAN ACT OF AGGRESSION IN INSTIGATING CHINESE COMMUNISTS TO GRASP POWER FROM THE LAWFUL GOVERNMENT AND IN SIMULTANEOUSLY SEIZING CHINESE TERRITORY WE CHINESE RESIDENTS IN BANDOENG LOYALLY SUPPORT NATIONAL GOVERNMENT IN TAIWAN ILLEGAL DEMAND OF CHINESE COMMUNISTS FOR ADMISSION TO UNITED NATIONS SHOULD BE DENIED IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN WORLD PEACE AND SECURITY MIN CIE LIBRARY FUKIEN ASSOCIATION, CHUNG HWA RELIEF ASSOCIATION, CHAUNG HWA PHIN MIN ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL, HWA CHAO YU BU MIDDLE SCHOOL YOUTH DRAMATIC ASSOCIATION, CHUNG HWA ASSOCIATION, HWA AN ASSOCIATION."

2. The text of the message from the Overseas Chinese in Djakarta is as follows:

"A MASS MEETING ATTENDED BY THREE THOUSAND OVERSEAS CHINESE TO CELEBRATE THE CHINESE NATIONAL DAY WAS HELD ON 10 OCTOBER AT DR SUN YAT-SEN MEMORIAL HALL DJAKARTA INDONESIA, AT WHICH A RESOLUTION WAS UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS: 'THE OVERSEAS CHINESE IN DJAKARTA REALIZING THAT THE CHINESE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT HAS A LEGITIMATE RIGHT IN TAIWAN HAVE RESOLVED THAT NO CHANGE OF ITS STATUS CAN BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF OUR NATIONAL GOVERNMENT' SIGNED WANGYUICHTAN CHAIRMAN"
