

"(1)A. No specified drug shall be imported, stocked or sold by wholesale unless it is under the direct responsibility of a registered apothecary."

Amends regulation 14 of the principal regulations. 3. For paragraph (1) of regulation 14 of the principal regulations there shall be substituted the following:

"(1) No medical practitioner may issue a prescription for any preparation consisting of or containing amphetamine, or any isomer of amphetamine, mecloqualone, methaqualone, methylphenidate, or phenmetrazine, or any salts or esters of any such drugs, or for any preparation consisting of secobarbital or of a combination of secobarbital and amobarbital, in either case in tablet or capsule form, or in sachet or cachet, or of any salts or esters thereof, unless he has the prior authorisation in writing by the Superintendent."

Substitutes First and Second Schedules to the principal regulations. 4. For the First and Second Schedules to the principal regulations there shall be substituted the following:

MEDICAL AND KINDRED PROFESSIONS ORDINANCE
(CAP.51)

DRUGS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) (No.2) REGULATIONS, 1981

exercise of the powers conferred by section 35A of the Medical and Kindred Professions Ordinance, the Minister of Health and Environment, on the advice of the Council of Health, has made the following regulations:

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Drugs (Control) (Amendment) (No.2) Regulations, 1981, and shall be read and construed as one with the Drugs (Control) Regulations, 1976 1/ hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations".

2. Immediately after the item "Barbital" in the Second Schedule to the principal regulations there shall be inserted the following item:

"Benzphetamine
