EXPENSES RESULTING FROM OBLIGATIONS PLACED ON THE UNITED NATIONS BY INSTRUMENTS RELATING TO THE CONTROL OF NARCOTIC DRUGS:

ASSESSMENT OF NON-MEMBER STATES BIGNATORIES OF THOSE INSTRUMENTS

Resolution adopted by the General Assembly at its 305th plenary meeting on 16 November 1950

(adopted on the report of the Fifth Committee (A/1497))

The General Assembly,

Taking note of the report of the Socretary-General to the fifth session of the General Assembly on the question of the assessment of signatories of international instruments relating to the control of narcotic drugs, which are non-members of the United Nations, for their fair share of expenses resulting from obligations placed on the United Nations by those instruments,

- 1. Approves the principle proposed by the Secretary-General for determining the expenses to be considered as assessable on such non-members;
- 2. Requests the Committee on Contributions to determine the rates at which such non-members should be assessed by the same method as that followed in determining the assessment of non-members which are parties to the Statute of the International Court of Justice for their share of the expenses of the Court;
- 3. <u>Directs</u> the Secretary-General to seek payment of such amounts as are determined by the method established above in respect of the 1950 expenses and those of future years.
