REGULATIONS OF 30 JUNE 1978 CONCERNING NARCOTIC DRUGS AND THE LIKE WITH SCHEDULE OF NARCOTIC DRUGS AMENDMENTS TO THE SCHEDULE OF NARCOTIC DRUGS 1/

To Norway's pharmacies, et al.

Pursuant to section 3, subsection 1 in the Regulations of 30 June 1978 concerning narcotic drugs and the like, laid down pursuant to sections 20 and 21 of Act no. 5 of 20 June 1964 relating to Medicaments and Poisons etc., cf. Royal Decree of 16 December 1977, 2/ the Director General of Public Health of Norway hereby makes the following amendments to the schedule of narcotic drugs. The following substances shall henceforth be included as indicated in the adjoining table:

Under "NOTES" after the schedule shall be added:

4. Preparations for oral use containing not more than 150 milligrammes of dextropropoxyphene salts per dosage unit or with a concentration of not more than 2.5 per cent in undivided preparations <u>/are exempted</u> provided that such preparations do not contain any substance controlled under the 1971 Convention on Psychotropic Substances.

These amendments enter into force immediately.
