APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE MEMBERSHIP
OF SUBSIDIARY BODIES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY

UNITED NATIONS ADMINISTRATIVE TRIBUNAL

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Refik ASHA (Syria)

1. In accordance with the allocation of agenda items approved by the General Assembly at its 342nd plenary meeting, the Fifth Committee, at its 319th meeting held on 18 December 1951, considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/1816) concerning the vacancies which will occur in the membership of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal as a result of the expiration of the initial terms of office of two of its members.
2. The Chairman had previously invited members of the Fifth Committee to submit the names of persons who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to membership of the Tribunal in accordance with article 3 of its Statute. At the time when the matter was considered by the Fifth Committee, the names of four candidates had been proposed.
3. The Committee having decided to follow the rules of procedure of the General Assembly with respect to elections for the purpose of determining who should be recommended for appointment, a vote by secret ballot was taken with the following result:
