THREATS TO THE POLITICAL INDEPENDENCE AND TERRITORIAL INTEGRITY OF GREECE

Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, addressed to the President of the General Assembly

New York, 29 October 1951

The Delegation of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations has received the following telegram from the mothers of ten persons charged in connexion with the case of the thirty-five Greek political prisoners:

"TSARAPKIN, UNITED NATIONS.

"The Royal Commissioner of the Athens Military Court has asked for the death sentence to be imposed upon G. BELAVILOS, K. STERGI, M. MOURATIDIS, T. SARIS, A. SARIS, G. BAZIKOS, K. MAVROSKOTIS, P. KALFAKAKIS, D. DANIS and G. KOTEAS.

"We, the mothers of the above-mentioned persons, ask you to do everything in your power to provent the shooting of our children.

"STERGI, STAMATIADIS, BELAVILOS, SARIS, BAZIKOS, KOTEAS, KALFAKAKIS, MAVROSKOTIS, DANIS.

Athens, 18 October 1951"

I have the honour, Mr. President, to request you to be guided by the humane approach to the question of the protection of the victims of political terror in Greece adopted at the third and fourth sessions of the General Assembly of the United Nations, and to take prempt steps through the United Nations to save the life of K. Mavroskotis, who has been condemned to death by the Athens Military Court.

Kindly issue my letter as a General Assembly document and distribute it to the delogations to the United Nations.
