THE APPROPRIATE ADJUSTMENT OF THE FRONTIERS BETWEEN  
EGYPT AND THE FORMER ITALIAN COLONY OF LIBYA,  
WITH PARTICULAR REFERENCE TO PARAGRAPHS 2  
AND 3 OF ANNEX XI OF THE TREATY OF  
PEACE WITH ITALY

Note by the Secretary-General

1. The General Assembly, by resolution 391 (V) of 14 December 1950, decided to defer to its sixth session consideration of the item on the agenda of its fifth session entitled "The appropriate adjustment of the frontiers between Egypt and the former Italian colony of Libya, with particular reference to paragraphs 2 and 3 of Annex XI of the Treaty of Peace with Italy".
2. It will be recalled that the item in question was included in the provisional agenda of the fifth session of the Assembly on a request made by the permanent representative of Egypt in a letter dated 12 July 1950 (A/1291). The General Assembly, on 26 September 1950, decided to include the item in its agenda and referred it to the Ad Hoc Political Committee for consideration and report. At its 80th meeting, on 13 December, the Committee took note of a statement by the representative of Egypt proposing that the item should be retained on the agenda of the General Assembly and its discussion postponed until the sixth session, and decided to make a recommendation to that effect to the General Assembly.
