Letter dated 29 September 1951 from the Acting Representative of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics to the United Nations, addressed to the President of the General Assembly

New York, 29 September 1951

Further to my letter of 25 September 1951 in which I forwarded to you a telegram from six Greek democratic organizations concerning eight Greek patriots and democrats now in prison under threat of execution, I have the honour to request you, on the strength of the humanitarian attitude adopted by the General Assembly at its third and fourth sessions in connexion with the protection of victims of the political terror in Greece, to take urgent measures through the United Nations to save the lives of the above-mentioned eight Greek patriots and democrats who have been sentenced to death, and also to take appropriate measures with regard to the other questions raised in the same telegram.

I would also ask you to have my present letter issued as a General Assembly document and circulated to the delegations to the United Nations.
