BOARD OF AUDITORS

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Rafik ASHA (Syria)

1. In accordance with the allocation of agenda items approved by the General Assembly at its 342nd plenary meeting, the Fifth Committee, at its 319th meeting held on 18 December 1951, considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/1814) concerning the vacancy which will occur in the membership of the Board of Auditors at the expiration of the term of office of one of the members of the Board on 30 June 1952.
2. The Chairman had previously invited the members of the Fifth Committee to make proposals with respect to Auditors General (or officials holding equivalent titles) of Member States who might be recommended to the General Assembly for appointment to membership of the Board of Auditors. The Committee was informed that the retiring member, the Auditor General of Denmark, would be willing to accept reappointment if this should be desired by the General Assembly. At the time when the matter was considered by the Fifth Committee, no other proposal had been submitted.
3. The reappointment of the Auditor General of Denmark having been accepted by acclamation, the Fifth Committee therefore recommends to the General Assembly

the adoption of the following resolution

APPOINTMENT TO FILL A VACANCY IN THE MEMBERSHIP OF
THE BOARD OF AUDITORS

The General Assembly,

Appoints the Auditor General of Denmark as a member of the Board of
Auditors for a three-year term to commence on 1 July 1952.
