INTERVENTION OF THE CENTRAL PEOPLE'S GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA IN KOREA

Additional measures to be employed to meet the aggression in Korea

Communication dated 30 May 1951 from the delegation of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic to the fifth session of the General Assembly, addressed to the Secretariat of the United Nations

New York, 30 May 1951

With reference to the telegram from the United Nations Secretariat to the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic containing a request to communicate to the Government of the Ukrainian SSR the text of the General Assembly resolution of 18 May 1951,^{1/} the delegation of the Ukrainian SSR to the fifth session of the General Assembly, on the instructions of the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Ukrainian SSR, begs to state as follows:

In view of the illegality of the said resolution, which was adopted under pressure from the United States of America and the aggressor bloc in the United Nations under United States leadership, as the delegation of the Ukrainian SSR has already stated in the First Committee and at the plenary meeting of the General Assembly, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Ukrainian SSR does not consider it possible to communicate to the Government of the Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic this illegal resolution, which is contrary to the Charter of the United Nations.

The delegation of the Ukrainian SSR to the fifth session of the General Assembly requests the Secretariat of the United Nations to issue this letter as a General Assembly document.
