The Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (Modification) Order 1979

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made	14th March 1979
Coming into Operation	14th May 1979

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 14th day of March 1979

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas a draft of this Order has been laid before Parliament on the recommendation of the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs and has been approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(2) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (a), 1/ is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (Modification) Order 1979 and shall come into operation on the expiration of the period of two months beginning with the day on which it is made.

2. Schedule 2 to the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (which, as amended (b), specifies the drugs which are subject to control under that Act) shall be amended by the insertion in paragraph 1(a) of Part I of that Schedule, after the word "Phenazocine", of the word "Phencyclidine".

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) Regulations 1979 and shall come into operation on 14th May 1979.

2. Schedule 2 to the Misuse of Drugs Regulations 1973 (b), 2/ shall be amended by the insertion in paragraph 1 of that Schedule, after the word "Phenazocine", of the word "Phencyclidine".

The Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1980

Made	8th February 1980
Laid before Parliament	18th February 1980
Coming into Operation	1st April 1980

In pursuance of sections 30 and 31 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (a), 1/ and after consultation with the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs, I hereby make the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1980 3/ and shall come into operation on 1st April 1980.

2. Regulation 3(1) of the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) Regulations 1979 (b) shall be amended as follows:

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a), for "£150" there shall be substituted "£174";
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b), for "£100" there shall be substituted "£116";
- (c) in sub-paragraph (c), for "£50" there shall be substituted "£58";
- (d) in sub-paragraph (d), for "£50" there shall be substituted "£58"; and
- (e) in sub-paragraph (e), for "£25" there shall be substituted "£29".

STATUTORY RULES OF NORTHERN IRELAND

Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979

Made 20th July 1979
Coming into Operation 1st September 1979

The Department of Health and Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 7, 10 and 31 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (a) 1/ as adapted by section 38 of the Act and now vested in it (b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1979.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 (c) shall apply to these regulations as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Amendment of the Misuse of Drugs (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1974

3. Schedule 2 to the Misuse of Drugs (Northern Ireland) Regulations 1974 (d), shall be amended by the insertion in paragraph 1, after the word "Phenazocine", of the word "Phencyclidine".

Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1980

Made 22nd February 1980

Coming into Operation 1st April 1980

The Department of Health and Social Services in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 30 and 31 of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971 (a) as adapted by section 38 of the Act and now vested in it (b) and of every other power enabling it in that behalf and after consultation with the Advisory Council on the Misuse of Drugs, hereby makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1980 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1980.

Interpretation

2. The Interpretation Act (Northern Ireland) 1954 (c) shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to a Measure of the Northern Ireland Assembly.

Amendment of the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) Regulations
(Northern Ireland) 1979

3. Regulation 3(1) of the Misuse of Drugs (Licence Fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 1979 (d) shall be amended as follows:

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a), for "£150" there shall be substituted "£174";
- (b) in sub-paragraph (b), for "£100" there shall be substituted "£116";
- (c) in sub-paragraph (c), for "£50" there shall be substituted "£58";
- (d) in sub-paragraph (d), for "£50" there shall be substituted "£58"; and
- (e) in sub-paragraph (e), for "£25" there shall be substituted "£29".
