THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 3 January 1990 from the representatives of Denmark,
Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden to the United Nations
addressed to the Secretary-General

On behalf of the Governments of the five Nordic countries, Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway and Sweden, we have the honour to inform you that as of today the assessed contributions for 1990 to the United Nations of all the Nordic countries have been forwarded from our capitals to the United Nations account.

The Nordic countries believe that the payment of their assessed contributions to the regular budget at the earliest possible date in the year is one way of expressing their strong and firm support for the world Organization.

The Nordic countries wish on this occasion to emphasize once more their whole-hearted support for the Secretary-General in his efforts to improve and strengthen the financial situation of the United Nations. They urge all other Member States to respond positively to the Secretary-General's appeal that assessed contributions be paid early and in full.
