Dear Mr. President:

The Kwajalein Atoll Corporation respectfully requests permission to present an oral petition to the United Nations Trusteeship Council during the session beginning on 17 May 1982. The Kwajalein Atoll Corporation is a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the Republic of the Marshall Islands. Its members include all Marshallese persons who enjoy land rights in Kwajalein Atoll under Marshallese custom and tradition.

The people of Kwajalein Atoll, through their representative, the Kwajalein Atoll Corporation, wish to present an oral petition to the Trusteeship Council on the subject of compensation for the use of Kwajalein Atoll by the United States Department of Defense between 1944 and 1979. The landowners of Kwajalein have never received adequate compensation from the United States for such use, and have demanded resolution of this issue prior to termination of the Trusteeship. 1/Accordingly, they would like to present their views of this matter orally for the benefit of the Trusteeship Council.
