Dear Sir:

Please give consideration to the following concerns and suggestions when you deliberate on the Pacific Trusteeship, 16-27 May:

- 1. We urge you to support the Palau Constitution and other means for promoting independence and self-government by the Pacific peoples.
- 2. Enforce a completely nuclear-free Pacific, including banning of weapon-storage and use, waste dumping and nuclear plants.
- 3. Enforce the clean-up of nuclear wastes.
- 4. In areas where the people need help in becoming self-sufficient, provide for gradual development with the help of the United Nations perhaps through the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and others.
