Dear Sir:

Please give consideration to the following concerns and suggestions when you deliberate on the Pacific Trusteeship, 16-27 May:

1. We urge you to support the Palau Constitution and other means for promoting independence and self-government by the Pacific peoples.
2. Enforce a completely nuclear-free Pacific, including banning of weapon-storage and use, waste dumping and nuclear plants.
3. Enforce the clean-up of nuclear wastes.
4. In areas where the people need help in becoming self-sufficient, provide for gradual development with the help of the United Nations - perhaps through the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP), United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) and others.

We appreciate the work you are doing and we wish you well in your efforts to bring about greater dignity, self-significance, and independence to people.
