NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Following consultations with the members of the Council, the President of the Security Council issued the following statement, on behalf of the members of the Council, on 20 August 1985:

Members of the Security Council have learnt with great concern the intention of the South African authorities to carry out shortly the death sentence imposed upon Mr. Malesela Benjamin Moloise.

Members of the Security Council recall the Council's resolution 547 of January 1984 which <u>inter alia</u> called upon the South African authorities not to carry out the execution of Mr. Moloise.

Members of the Security Council once again urge the South African authorities to rescind the death sentence imposed on Mr. Moloise, convinced that the carrying out of the execution, apart from being a direct defiance of the above-mentioned Security Council resolution, will result in the further deterioration of an already extremely grave situation.
